March 25 edition. Welcome. Our list changes often. You'll always find the latest edition on our website, www.hillkeep.ca, along with a Plants Index, a How to Order page, and usually photographs with detailed descriptions. Many plants not mentioned in this .pdf are on our website. If you skip the website you may miss some plants you have been longing for. These remarks underline the difference between a big, "don't make customers lift a finger" operation and one that focuses on plants and is run by two people.

What's new this year (in part): more crocuses with highly divided stigmata; more fritillaries of the garden persuasion; some exceedingly rare colchicums, irises and hellebores; a big increase in our stock of desirable members of the hyacinth family (now partly the asparagus family); gorgeous alliums selected by Mark McDonough; sternbergias. **Still to be added** are more bulbs of W North America and more peonies from all over, grown from seed; more epimediums; and you will find far more other perennials, shrubs and trees on our website than we have yet managed to type into this list.
